Anthurium Lily	All year	Red, pink, orange, cream/white, lime green, chocolate, yellow	An exotic and waxy looking heart-shaped flower with a long stamen.
Arum lily	August – October	Cream	Slender cone-shaped flower with a long yellow stamen.
Asiatic lilies	All Year – Very Soft for traveling	Pink, Yellow, Burgundy, Orange, Cream, terracotta, apricot	Exotic, six-petaled flower forming a star shape – non-fragrant
Aussie Natives	Most all year	Proteas, Banksias, Leucodendrons, Wax, Gum, Kangaroo Paw, Berries, Nuts	Variety of Australian Wild Flowers
Baby's Breath	All Year	White, Pink	Bunches of tiny, delicate, ball-like flowers
Bamboo	All year	Green, Chocolate, Gold	Tall hollow trunk with joints
Berries	Seasonal	Green – Brezillia, Ivy, Brunei Brown – Ivy Grey – Tetragonia	Assorted styles and shapes of berries
Birds of paradise	Spring, Summer, Autumn	Orange flower with blue tongue	Many petals opening into a fan of orange with few blue petals
Blushing Brides	June? July, August, September	Pink, White	Papery white floral leaves, surrounding feathery tufts of white to pinkish flowers
Calla Lilly	June – October	Lemon, mango, mauve/pink, deep rich purple & burgundy	Cone-shaped thick-petaled flower with thick stem
Carnations/Spray carnations	All year	White, Lemon, Shades of pink, Red, yellow, Burgundy, Orange, Lime, and bi-colours	Round frilly cluster of petals
**Cattleya orchid	Winter Spring	White, lavender, yellow/gold, bi-colours	Large & small varieties – flower with two oval-shaped and three pointed petals with a cone-frilled shaped throat
**Cymbidium orchid	Winter - 15/5 to 1/8	White, cream, pink, green, brown, burgundy, yellow and bi-colours	Thick, waxy flowers with five pointed petals and a curly throat
Daffodil	Spring	Yellow	Small flowers with mid-length stems
Daisy / Pompom Chrysanthemum	All Year	White, cream, yellow, orange, plum, red, salmon, burgundy, lilac and lime green	Tall, multi-bloom flowers with flat centre surrounded by petals or pompom of small petals
David Austin Roses	Summer ONLY	White, pale pink, medium pink, deep pink, apricot, lemon	Fragrant, many-petal cabbage-like garden rose, a very expensive boutique rose
**Dendrobium/Singapore Orchids	All Year	White, pinks, mauve, deep purple, Lime, fuchsia pink	Single stem with multiple star-shaped flowers up stem, buds on tip of stem
Doda Vine	All year	Green, Chocolate	Stringy, knotty vines
Dutch Iris	All Year – Not recommended in summer heat fragile in our climate	Blue = All Year Lilac, White & Yellow = Seasonal	Long stalks with large petals, three of which droop down
English Lavender	Summer – Very Fragile- not recommended	Lilac, blue	Sweet scented with elegant form. The average flower head has six to ten whole buds stretched along the stem beneath the main head – fragrant
Freesia	Winter/Spring	White, yellow, red, purple/mauve, pink	Small fragrant trumpet flower with multiple blooms along stem – fragrant
Frangipani	Nov-March	White/lemon, pale pink, fruit salad	VERY seasonal blooms – weather permitting – fragile – bruise easily
Gardenia	Spring – Not recommended here in our climate, bruises easily	White	Large, round waxy flower with dark leaves and beautiful fragrance. Not recommended in our climate as they are too fragile, petals brown if touched

Gerbera & Mini gerberas	All year	White, yellow, pink, red, orange, gold, lemon, some with contrasting centers	A giant version of the common daisy- large flower Also mini form
Gladioli	Spring/Summer	White, Lime, Orange, Purple, Pink, Yellow, Salmon	Tall central stem with blooms flowering from base to top.
Green goddess lily	July – early November	Green / cream throat	A unique calla lily with white centers flushed with green and broad green tips
Hyacinth	Winter/Spring	White, blue dark/pale, pink, cream, mauve	Short, heavy stem with multiple small star-shaped flowers. Extremely fragrant
Ivy – Trailing, bunching	All year	Green, White/ Green variegated	Trailing or bunching foliage
Lace Rose	Summer ONLY	Porcelain pink, medium pink, silver/mauve, lavender pink	Fluffy rose variety resembling David Austin Roses, multiple blooms per stem, elegant
Lisianthus	Spring, Summer, Autumn	White, Cream, Pink, Purple, Mauve, Lime and Some bi-colours	Resembles a large fluffy blown rose.
**Mokara Orchid	All year	Yellow, Purple, Fuchsia, Terracotta/Oranges, Shades of pink.	Shortish stem, flat spidery petals sometimes speckled. Approx 8 flowers per stem.
November Lilies	Spring/Summer/Autumn	White, white/pink throat	Long, slender trumpet blooms with a pointed tip that opens in a star shaped bloom of six large petals-subtle fragrance
**Oenidium orchids	All year/ some seasonal	Yellow, White/burgundy, Brown/lemon.	Tiny flattish flowers branches off main central stem. Dainty
Oriental lilies	All Year	White, blush pinks/hot pink, yellow	Exotic looking star-shaped flowers with long slender stamen surrounded by five smaller offshoots – VERY FRAGRANT
Peony	Nov – Dec ONLY	White, pale and deep pinks	Large, round cabbagey rose-like bloom on a strong stem- soft powdery perfume
**Phalaenopsis Orchid	Sept – Dec local growers (most of year) Must be ordered early, specialised	White, lilac, purple, Bi - colours	Also known as moth orchids due to their shape. Multiple orchids on a stem. Exotic/Tropical
Ranunculus	August, September	White, Yellow, Burgundy, Orange, Red	A round, many petal flat top bloom
Roses & Mini Roses	All Year	White, cream, champagne, all shades of pink, yellow, gold, red, salmon, lilac, lime green, orange, bi-colours	Small to large in size, slight to strong fragrance, some boast full blooms while others don't open fully. Tineke is the most popular white rose
Spear Grass/ blue poles/ Flat grass	All year	Green	Tall grasses/ Tall reeds
Stephanotis	Dec - Jan	Pure white	Small, waxy white trumpet star shaped flowers-fragrant
Succulents	All year	Grey, Sage, peaches	Solid waxy floret's
Sunflower	Summer	Yellow with black center / all yellow fluffy	Large bold daisy like bloom
Tropical foliage/leaves	All year	Greens, variegated, Sage colours	Different sizes and shapes. Palm – Raphis, Golden cane Leaves – Philadendrons, Aspidistra, Cordyline, Happy leaves, Anthirium leaves, Monstera, Dieffenbachia, Dracaenas, Landau, Liriopi.
Tulip	Winter – Not recommended in our climate, very fragile	White, cream, pink, orange, red, purple and varying shades in between	U.shaped flower -
**Vanda orchids	All Year	Yellow, Purples, Fuchsia	Flat round petals, Not unlike Phalaenopsis.
